



Tideland Secures Large Service Contract With Pemex

Pemex, Mexico's oil producer, has signed an open contract with Tideland Signal Corporation to upgrade the Aids to Navigation equipment located on their largest oilfield complex.



The total amount for this contract is \$5,000,000, which will be implemented in 2005 and 2006. Tideland Signal joins the exclusive list of suppliers such as Siemens and General Electric who have an open contract with Pemex.

A major portion of this contract will be spent in the renewal of equipment and the installation of a new remote monitoring and control system for the equipment. This investment is being made in PEMEX's largest oil field complex named Cantarell. Cantarell is located a few miles of the coast in the north part of the Peninsula of Yucatan. It has 4 complexes that control a total of 70 platforms in which they will be installing approximately 300 ML-300UL marine lanterns, specifically designed for classified zones. In addition, many new and replacement solar power systems will be installed.

Without a doubt the signature of this contract represents a success for Tideland Signal and will open many doors for future involvement in projects located in Latin America.
