



Tideland Signal – The Chosen One

His Majesty, The King of Thailand, is celebrating his 80th Birthday December 5, 2007. To commemorate this auspicious event, the Customs Department of Thailand has built a new lighthouse, which is the biggest and tallest in Thailand. This lighthouse is situated in Ranong province. Tideland's TRB-220 rotating beacon has been chosen to mark this lighthouse for its quality, reliability and brilliance of its excellent optics.

Ranong province is situated near Myanmar and is rich in culture and natural resources. To attract tourists in Phuket to also visit Ranong, the Customs Department took the initiative to build the biggest lighthouse in Thailand. The new lighthouse, measuring 48M, has an elevator to bring tourists to a viewing gallery cum restaurant. The viewing gallery offers a spectacular view of Ranong Province and part of Myanmar. It offers the best sunset view in the whole of Thailand.

The Customs Department is extremely satisfied with Tideland's TRB 220 and is confident that it will surpass the design requirement and assist in bringing in more tourists.

This is not the first time Tideland equipment has been selected for such events in Thailand. Tideland's TRB-400 rotating beacon has been operating in the King's Memorial Lighthouse for over 10 years. The TRB-400 was selected by Royal Thai Navy to mark his Excellency's 50th year of rule of the Kingdom of Thailand.
