What sets this combination apart is that one lantern, the MLED-155, with appropriate power setting, can be used in any of Class A, B or C, thus eliminating the need to stock multiple types or sizes of lanterns.

This lantern combination utilizes input power on the order of one-half to one-third of that required by competitor lanterns, thus providing another cost saving to the end user.

Other features include hardwire synchronization and optional GPS synchronization.
